

ILLNESS POLICY

For the well being of all children and staff, it is necessary that all sick children remain at home. If a child exhibits the symptoms listed below, they should not be brought to St. Mary Child Development Center. In addition, if a child exhibits any of the following symptoms, listed below, while present at the Center the parent(s) will be asked to pick him or her up immediately. In the event the parents cannot be reached, St. Mary CDC will then call the first person listed on the child's emergency card.

The child shall not attend the child care facility until the symptoms are no longer exhibited for a 24 hour period without Tylenol, aspirin, Advil or other fever reducing medications.

- Fever of 100 degrees or more
- Thick and/or green discharge from nose, eyes or ears (non-allergy related)
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Lice
- Unusual fatigue
- Unexplained rash
- Communicable disease

Communicable diseases or any illness should be reported immediately to the Director. A notice of any communicable disease will be posted relaying the information to all parents. There are no tuition adjustments for illness, unless the illness extends for more than two weeks.
